

Consent Agreement to the Parent Rules of the Wellesley Chinese Language School (WCLS)

To ensure a productive and safe learning environment at the Wellesley Chinese Language School (WCLS), all parents/guardians have the ultimate responsibility to follow the parent rules issued by the WCLS. All parents/guardians will be required to understand and sign the following consent agreement.

1. By reading this form, I _____ acknowledge WCLS is a non-profit organization. All parents/guardians voluntarily send their child(ren) to WCLS and waive all liability claims and will not sue the WCLS and its personnel. All parents will be responsible for their own child(ren)'s safety and any unforeseen bodily or personal injuries and casualty, or event involving WCLS.
2. Parents or guardians should accompany their child(ren) or ensure their child(ren) arriving at WCLS safely.
3. Parents/guardians should remind their child(ren) not to go to the areas other than the classrooms assigned to the WCLS, and that they are restricted to the second floor rental rooms. Don't use rooms not rented by the WCLS for use.
4. Parents/guardians should remind their child(ren) not to use, move, or modify any classroom items belong to the Church.
5. Parents/guardians are liable for any and all property damage caused by their child(ren).
6. Parents agree to provide voluntary service to the WCLS coordinated by the WCLS school parent committee during school operation time and agree to pay \$50 to waive the responsibility.
7. Parents/guardians should remind their child(ren) to follow all the Student Rules of WCLS. Parents/guardians should cooperate with teachers to address any concerns regarding their child(ren)'s behavior at school. No running and no shouting at school. Food is not allowed in the classroom.
8. Parents/guardians are responsible for their child(ren)'s Chinese study at home. Parents/guardians should encourage, help, and monitor their child(ren) to complete homework, test preparation, and other related activities. In case of confusion, parents/guardians should proactively contact a teacher to clarify issues.
